Regulations 2015 regarding Examination System for the students of MS/MD (Sub Specialty) Degree Programs in Medical and Dental Sciences, made under Section 22 (1) (iii) of the Isra University Act, 1997.

Short Title: These Regulations shall be called, "The Isra University Regulations 2015 regarding Examinations System for the students of MS/MD (Sub Specialty) Degree Programs in Medical and Dental Sciences, made under Section 22 (1) (iii) of the Isra University Act, 1997".

- 1. Commencement: These Regulations shall come into force with effect from January 2015.
- 2. Definitions: "University" means "Isra University"

3. Attendance:

(1) Students are required to maintain at least 80% attendance in their theory, laboratory, tutorial classes and clinical duties (O.P.D., Ward & O.T.). Those who fail to keep up the required attendance in the subject will not be allowed to appear in the examination of that subject. However, when the candidate completes the required deficiency, he/she will be allowed to appear in the next semester examination.

(2) In hardship cases, the committee consisting of the following members will examine the cases and recommend to the Vice Chancellor for grant of exemption up to 10% only:

- 4. Controller of Examinations

4. Award of degree:

1) After completion of course works successfully, the students will appear in final certifying examination and also submit his/her thesis or two articles published in PM&DC/CPSP recognized journals.

2) Three external examiners and one internal examiner other than supervisor (if available) will be invited in final certifying examination to assess the student in the major subject as well as his thesis work.

5. Examination

The Final Certifying Examination will be held if the supervisor of the student certifies that he/she has successfully completed Clinical Training work.

1) Theory Paper

* "There will be two theory papers consisting of ten essay type questions."

2) Practical:

Practical Examination of 200 marks will include Short Cases and OSCE.

6. Modification:

The Regulations are subject to modification by the concerned authority as may be felt appropriate from time to time.
